Expectations for those receiving Confirmation this year

Saints Paper: Please do a paper over a Saint of your choosing. We would like to know what this Saint means to you and how they provide an example for your faith. Please complete by March 1, 2018. Please return to the youth ministry office either in person or by mail.

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Priest Discussion: We want to know more about your faith journey and talk about your future after Confirmation. We will be setting discussion times. We will sit around, eat some pizza, and talk about your Confirmation journey and where it will go.

Service Hours: We ask that youth complete service hours, because it is important that we serve our fellow man. What we ask is that you do as many hours as you feel is appropriate. Our goal is not that you get a certain set of hours. Our goal and hope is that you learn from whatever service you provide to family, friends, community organizations etc....We would ask that you turn in a minimum ½ page paper describing the service you have done since June 2017, what it taught you, and why it was important.

CONFIRMATION: WHAT IS IT?

In the Catechism, Confirmation is known as “The completion of Baptism”. What promises are you re-committing to?

- V. Do you reject Satan?
- V. And all his works?
- V. And all his empty promises?
- V. Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth?
- V. Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary was crucified, died, and was buried, rose from the dead, and is now seated at the right hand of the Father?
- V. Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

What is it not?

- It is not you becoming an adult member of the Church.
 - At Baptism you became a member of the Church.
 - At Eucharist you reached the “Source and Summit” of our faith with full responsibilities.
- It is not you deciding to become Catholic.
 - You are Catholic at baptism.
- It is not just that you are receiving the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.
 - It is you receiving a deeper understanding of how to use those gifts.

Who can receive Confirmation?

- Within the age range in this Diocese Grades 8 and up.
- Profess the faith.
- Be in the state of Grace.
- Desire to receive the Sacraments.
- Intend to live as a disciple of Christ and witness to the faith, both within the Church and the world.

How do I pick a Sponsor?

- A sponsor needs to be:
 - At least 16 years of age, confirmed, and baptized.
 - Must be a practicing Catholic.
- A sponsor *should* be:
 - Someone that you as the Confirmation candidate picks.
 - Not just an honorary family title.
 - Not someone who is picked for you.
 - Someone who is educated in the faith and is able to give you answers about faith.
 - Someone whom you look to and want as part of your life long-term.
 - Someone whom you trust, as they are sponsoring you not just for a day but in your entire faith life.
- Make a list of people in your life that fit the above criteria.
 - Then sit with your parents to discuss the people.
 - Parents should not force a particular sponsor on a candidate.
 - Discuss why someone might be a good choice.
 - Then ask that person if they would be your sponsor.

WHAT DOES A PAST PARTICIPANT SAY ABOUT THIS CONFERENCE? By: Stephanie Schoch

I was told it would be a life changing experience. That was all that I could think of as we began the six hour ride. I had only ever heard wonderful things about the historical Abbey located in the small town of St. Meinrad, Indiana. As we got closer and closer, I felt farther away from society, winding through steep hills and down long roads. Finally, we reached the peak, gazing upon the "Holy Hill". There was a sense of calmness that washed over me the second I stepped out of the car.

The seemingly long car ride was a small price to pay for the week that was ahead. There was the dance, the masses morning and night, the echo of the monks' chant, bellowing across the massive white Church. Everything about the week was perfect. The fact that everyone there already had something in common, their faith, made everything more comfortable.

The things that I had heard were correct. After five straight days of peace and clarity, I finally understood why the people I had asked about St. Meinrad said that they could not explain why it is so amazing. St. Meinrad not only teaches theology, but teaches people both a way of life, and way of faith.

5 days, 120 hours, 7200 minutes: that was all that I needed on the "Holy Hill". All that I needed to change my perspective on Indiana, on life and most importantly on my faith.

WHAT IS THIS CONFERENCE?

"**One Bread, One Cup**" is a liturgical leadership conference focusing on the Word, Sacrament and Mission of the Roman Catholic Church. Conferences focus on community building, leadership development, catechesis, liturgical and spiritual formation, and theological reflection. There are opportunities for personal prayer and contemplation, liturgical prayer, charity and action, and vocational discernment while living and actively participating in an intentional Christian community. At the conferences, youth and adults discover the Church's treasures of Word, Sacrament and Mission and enjoy opportunities for fellowship and fun through team building, outdoor recreation, a variety show and a dance. Participants come to appreciate the Benedictine balance of prayer, work and recreation.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST? The entire cost is \$750. However, there are scholarships available. Please let me know if you need scholarship assistance. We want everyone to go that can!

WHEN WILL WE ATTEND? We will attend two conferences (June 14-20) and (June 25-31). **There are only 10 spots per conference! It is done on a 1st- come basis!**
